Cambridge is located about 60 miles (100 Km) from London. Its university was founded in the twelfth century by disaffected academics from Oxford University. The oldest building from that time is in St John's College but the oldest surviving college is Peterhouse. Cambridge and Oxford are similar distances from London: Oxford lies to the west and Cambridge to the north.


Cambridge and the surrounding area hold an unrivalled reputation for being a centre of excellence both in learning and ambience. Now its famous Colleges are home to over 17,000 students - Kings College Chapel is a familiar image all over the world. Cambridge's heritage also includes an outstanding record of scientific and artistic achievements -Newton, Darwin, Wordsworth, Milton, Ian McKellan, John Cleese, Emma Thompson and Zadie Smith were all educated here. Cambridge is small and can only be visited on-foot. Expect to walk for most of your visit. We do hope that by joining us in Cambridge next summer you will also be able to experience and take advantage of all of that Cambridge has to offer.

Arrival & Departure:

- Students begin lessons on a Monday and should aim to arrive on Sunday afternoon
- On departure rooms must be vacated by 10am Saturday morning
- When booking your flights, please check with your airline what documents are required if your child is classified as an 'unaccompanied minor', usually applies to travellers under 17 years old
- Students under 17 will be met at the airport arrival hall and accompanied through to the entrance
 of the departure hall when returning home
- Arrivals that are outside of Sunday afternoon times have to be discussed with the Admissions Office and may be subject to an additional fee

Excursions and Activities:

we believe that there is a lot of learning exposure students get through excursions hence we arrange visits of some cultural interest combined with either sight-seeing, shopping or an arranged activity. Typical activities include; a tour of Oxford, Stratford-upon-Avon, punting on the river at Cambridge, a day out at Alton Towers Theme Park and London where we make visits to art galleries and many of the well known tourist attractions.

However students must be prepared to do lots of walking as this is usually the easiest and most enjoyable way to see our cities!

*Each year we try to vary the places we visit and make our choice in line with the ages and interests of the students and events that are taking place in the UK.

The afternoon excursions will have an educational theme and trips are selected in line with the weather conditions at the time. Our summer weather can vary!

The social programme will take place every evening between 19.00 - 21.00 and will include various activities including craft nights, in-house entertainment and sports; Badminton, Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Table Tennis and Tennis. Students should also pack a swimming costume, as we sometimes visit the local pool.

Excursions

Travel, food and group activities are included in the course fees. Additional drinks, refreshments, souvenirs and personal shopping are extra and should be paid for by the student.

There will be an optional trip to London .This is at an extra cost of £95. There are limited places for this trip which will be allocated to students who sign up first. We will go on one excursion per week and destinations are likely to be:

Courses We Offer

Students can stay for a minimum of one week but we would recommend 2 weeks to get a full experience of what is on offer.

INTRODUCTION TO LAW

Students will look at the different specialist areas of law, the ethical and political principals that underlie the way Law operates and issues highlighted in case law.

Students will learn about constitutional law, jurisprudence, legal systems and reasoning, criminal law, tort law and the ethical issues surrounding law.

INTRODUCTION TO ENGINEERING

Students will gain an understanding of the different specialist areas of engineering, improve their technical and analytical skills, focus on the academic knowledge needed and learn how to pursue a career in engineering.

INTRODUCTION TO MEDICINE

Students will be given an insight into the practical and theoretical knowledge needed to study medicine such as human anatomy and the science behind medicine. This gives students the ability to assess whether they would enjoy and be suited to a medical career in the future.

SAT PREPARATION

This course focuses on all areas of SAT preparation: Critical Reading, Mathematics and Writing. Students will take part in practice tests and will be provided with continuous feedback on how to answer and prepare for each question

UK UNIVERSITY PREPARATION COURSES

This course provides students about to commence Sixth Form the relevant subject overview, skills, and know-how to navigate the courses. It is a perfect introduction to Sixth Form Studies and Study Skills to transit effectively from Secondary to Sixth Form studies.

UK A'LEVEL/IB PREPARATION COURSES

This course provides students with advice and information for applying to UK universities. The course highlights what is expected of students when applying, writing their personal statement and throughout the interview process.
